**CONSENT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME FOR NON-PARTY REPORTERS
TONI LOCY AND JAMES STEWART
TO RESPOND TO PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR CIVIL CONTEMPT**

Non-party reporters Tony Locy and James Stewart, by counsel, respectfully submit this Consent Motion to extend their time, from December 3, 2007 to December 17, 2007, to respond to the plaintiff's motions to hold them in civil contempt. In support of this Consent Motion, the non-party reporters state as follows:

1. On October 2, 2007, plaintiff moved to hold non-party reporters Toni Locy and James Stewart in civil contempt. Docket Nos. 204-05.
2. On October 9, 2007, a consent motion to stay/for a protective order was filed under seal. Docket No. 208.
3. By Order dated October 9, 2007, the Court granted the sealed consent motion. It stayed proceedings until December 3.
4. The Court also ordered that transcripts of the depositions now underway be sealed until December 3, but also ordered that the responses of Locy and Stewart to the contempt motions be filed on that date.

5. The non-party reporters need sufficient time to review the now-sealed deposition transcripts in order to respond to plaintiff's contempt motion. Accordingly, they respectfully request that their time to respond to the motions for civil contempt be extended up to and including December 17, 2007.

6. Counsel for all parties have consented to this motion.
